This league is for players 19 years and older. All abilities are welcome. Each team's rating must add up to 7.0 or less (e.g. two 3.0 players, two 3.5 players, one 3.0 player and one 4.0 player, one 2.5 player and one 4.5 player). If you play USTA or SATA, use the higher of your USTA or SATA rating. Otherwise, provide a self-rating following NTRP guidelines from the USTA website. Antelope Community Tennis Association will provide new balls and complimentary refreshments each week.

1. Cost is \$25 per player for the duration of each session.
2. Barry Ross (916-203-9728) is the league scheduler.
3. All matches are scheduled for 8:30 a.m., Saturday mornings at Antelope Tennis Center or Center High School.
4. The league scheduler will provide the complete 8-match league schedule at the beginning of the league before the first match.
5. Awards will be presented to the top two doubles teams and top two singles players.
6. Players who would like to sub can sign-up and check the SUB box. Subs play free.
7. Sign-ups must be paid in full at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the session. Late registrations will be accepted only if space is available, and if the schedules have not been made.

**GENERAL**

I understand that the above activity may be of hazardous nature and/or include physical and/or strenuous exercise or activity; that serious accidents occasionally occur during the above activity; and that participants in the above activity occasionally sustain mortal or personal injuries and/or property damages as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risk involved, nevertheless, I have voluntarily applied to participate in said activity and I hereby agree to assume any and risk of injury or death and to release and hold harmless the above organizations (their officers, employees, and agents) who through negligence, carelessness, or any other act or omission might otherwise be liable to me. ## COMBO LEAGUE RULES

1. Emphasis is on playing all matches as scheduled. All attempts must be made to play matches at the designated league time and location. Any rescheduled matches must be played and the scores reported to the league scheduler within one week of the originally scheduled match and before the next scheduled match. Both teams must mutually agree to the date and time of the rescheduled match. If the rescheduled match is cancelled for some reason, then the team that was originally unable to play on the Saturday must forfeit.
2. Winning team must report the match scores to the league scheduler (Barry Ross).
3. Teams must complete 75% of matches or risk league suspension.
4. Players are responsible for getting their own subs. Please contact as many people as possible.
5. Subs must be near the same level as the league. (No Ringers)
6. If both partners on a team cannot play, you must forfeit the match. (Two subs on a team are not allowed).
7. If your team must forfeit, you are responsible to contact your opponents in advance of the scheduled match. If you do not contact your opponents, you risk league suspension.
8. If weather looks questionable, call the designated league official to find out if the league has been cancelled.
9. In the event of rain or other cause of officially postponed matches, the make-up matches will be rescheduled by the league scheduler at the end of the regular season, and before playoff (if playoffs are necessary). Continue to follow your original schedule until the league scheduler provides a revised schedule.
10. Scoring:
  - a. The Doubles and Singles competitions are scored, recorded, and awarded separately.
  - b. Doubles:
    - i. The home team serves first. The away team chooses the starting side.
    - ii. Each match consists of 3 sets.
      1. The first 2 sets are no-add sets. If the set score gets to 5-all, play a 12-point tie breaker (first to 7 points win by two).
      2. The third set consists of an 18-point tie breaker (first to 10 points win by two).
    - iii. Teams are awarded one point for each set won.
    - iv. Forfeiting team receives 0 points, non-forfeiting team receives 3 points
    - v. Teams with a sub receive one-half point for each set won.
  - c. Singles:
    - i. The home team will decide the match-ups for the two singles matches.
    - ii. The away team serves first. The home team chooses the starting side.
    - iii. The match consists of one set no-add. If the set score gets to 5-all, play a 12-point tie breaker (first to 7 points win by two).
    - iv. Winning player receives 2 points.
    - v. Losing player receives 1 point.
    - vi. Forfeiting player receives 0 points; non-forfeiting player receives 2 points.
